Richard dominated the prices with his trio of heifers averaging £2240 to a top of £2320. Peter Bauls', Bishop Thornton, Reserve Champion and second placed heifer realised 1900, whilst Jeremy Taylor, Broughton, sold to £1780. for the third place. In general, trade was maintained for the top end but much harder work to place the second quality stock. George and Gladys Emmott took all the places in the incalf class, selling to a top of £1600. With no young cows forward, top place went to G Woodmancey & Son's 5th calver at £920.
